#### Diabetes Among Friends

A five-week diabetes self-management education curriculum in English and Spanish from Scripps University, debuted in our rural health clinics in July 2017. During our 17 classes, 92 people graduated with new life skills to manage their diabetes and prevent long term complications of the disease.
