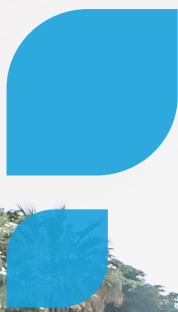

These services include immunizations, nutrition screenings via hemoglobin levels, information and education, and referral and linkage services.

#### "Kaur Care" Sikh Community Health Screenings

We partnered with the Sikh Women's Association to perform biometric screenings (blood pressure and glucose), clinics breast cancer exams, childhood immunizations, flu shots and cervical cancer exams at south Bakersfield gurdwaras.
